- 3. One-page narrative as to firm's areas of expertise, particular abilities, and qualifications related to this project.
- 4. Resumes of key personnel to be assigned to this project.
- 5. Current workload/ability to perform this work.
- 6. Similar project experience.
- 7. Three (3) Letters of Reference from past clients relative to WSCBA or similar efforts.
