Tracey:

- HS visits for 8th graders will be May 31st in the morning for both LC and Ferris kids. Permission slips will be coming home soon.

- 7th Grade science walking to Manito May 21-23

- 5th graders will be visiting Sac. See your elementary school for exact dates.
- MAP Testing results looked really good. (MAP is an adaptive test and SBAC tests on grade level standards). MAP Results below:
 - ELA: 6th grade: 67%, 7th Grade 73%, 8th Grade 58%
 - MATH: 6th Grade: Fall 56% Spring 89%. 7th Grade: Fall 73% Spring 99% (Tracey was very impressed by this. No one else in the country is seeing growth like this). 8th Grade: Fall 72% Spring 75%. Tracey said this is typical for 8th grade. This is the year they start to see behavioral issues, body changes, etc.
 - SCIENCE: 6th Grade: 77%, 7th Grade 83%, 8th Grade 81%
- They are not seeing as much growth in ELA. Noticing it a lot with the advanced English classes as they are already at the top and it's hard to advance when you're doing well.

Treasurer's Report:

- See report for actual numbers. Pending balance is \$11,262.15
- Extra money in account. Board approved to spend the money on teacher appreciation week (lunch, gift cards, coffee), approved a teacher request and added money to 8th grade fun for a photo booth.
- Holding \$1,000 for next year in case there is no sponsor for honor roll donuts.
- 23/24 was a good fundraising year. Budgeted less for next year since we'll have less students. Two line items were separated out: Sac Gives and LC Feeder Funds. (Next years LC feeder events will be: Tailgate, Rubber Chicken and a MultiCultural event).

- Jeff Klein motioned to approve the budget for 24/25. Becky Ammerman second the motion. All approved.

Presidents Report:

- A teacher requested backpacks. Any new or like new backpacks that you no longer need would be greatly appreciated. They will keep extras on hand for next year as well.
- Volunteers/Chairs needed for next year: Lead for teacher grants (fairly easy, send out requests to teachers, collect them and organize. 2-3 week total length of task). Lead for staff appreciation week in May.
- Flower Baskets went well. New vendor and he was great. He dropped off when asked and left a few extra. 66 patio pots sold. 64 hanging pots sold and 6 flats of geraniums sold. 131 pre-sold and the extras were sold the day of pickup. Next year hoping to presell 150. Profit made was \$1,487. Will work on how to better organize the collecting of money and advertising.
