 - i. Player and Team Development
 - ii. Evaluate all levels of program
- d. 3 Teams for Incoming 9th-12th Grade
 - i. 8-10 players on Varsity, 10-12 players on Junior Varsity, 12+ on Freshman
 - ii. Determining Teams – Coaches will communicate throughout Week 1
 - iii. Fluid time for teams, compete for spots, possibility to “swing”
