## **CALL FOR RESOURCES CFR 2324-05** **Crisis De-escalation and Intervention**

Spokane Public Schools is looking for an evidence-based trauma informed de-escalation training and crisis intervention program that supports the elimination of isolation and offers interventions to reduce the need for restraint. The system should provide a range of training levels from verbal interventions to physical holds.

**The District expects the approved product would be in place for training in August of 2024.**

Elements Required:

- Trauma informed
- Offers certification in nonviolent crisis intervention and verbal interventions
- Evidence of reduction of restraint and seclusion
- OSPI Recommended Crisis Program
- Does not provide training in the use of prone restraint
