

PICK UP AND DROP OFF (pages 21-22)

For the safety of all children, families are expected to abide by the following expectations before and after school.









No-Idle Zone: The pick-up/drop off loop on the south side of the building is a no-idle zone. Carbon monoxide, nitrogen oxides and volatile organic compounds released in vehicle exhaust are particularly harmful to children. Their respiratory systems are still developing and exposure to pollution can lead to a variety of health issues. Please turn off your vehicle as you wait to pick up your Jefferson

scholar.

<u>Crosswalks</u>: Adults are expected to use designated crossings to and from school property and in the direct front of the school to travel to the parking spaces across from the pick-up and drop-off loop. Children watch what adults do more than what they say, so adults are asked to please be safe role models for not only their own children, but for all children.





Altitude Trampoline Night - CANCELED


The trampoline park night, originally scheduled for tomorrow 6/4 will be rescheduled for the fall.
